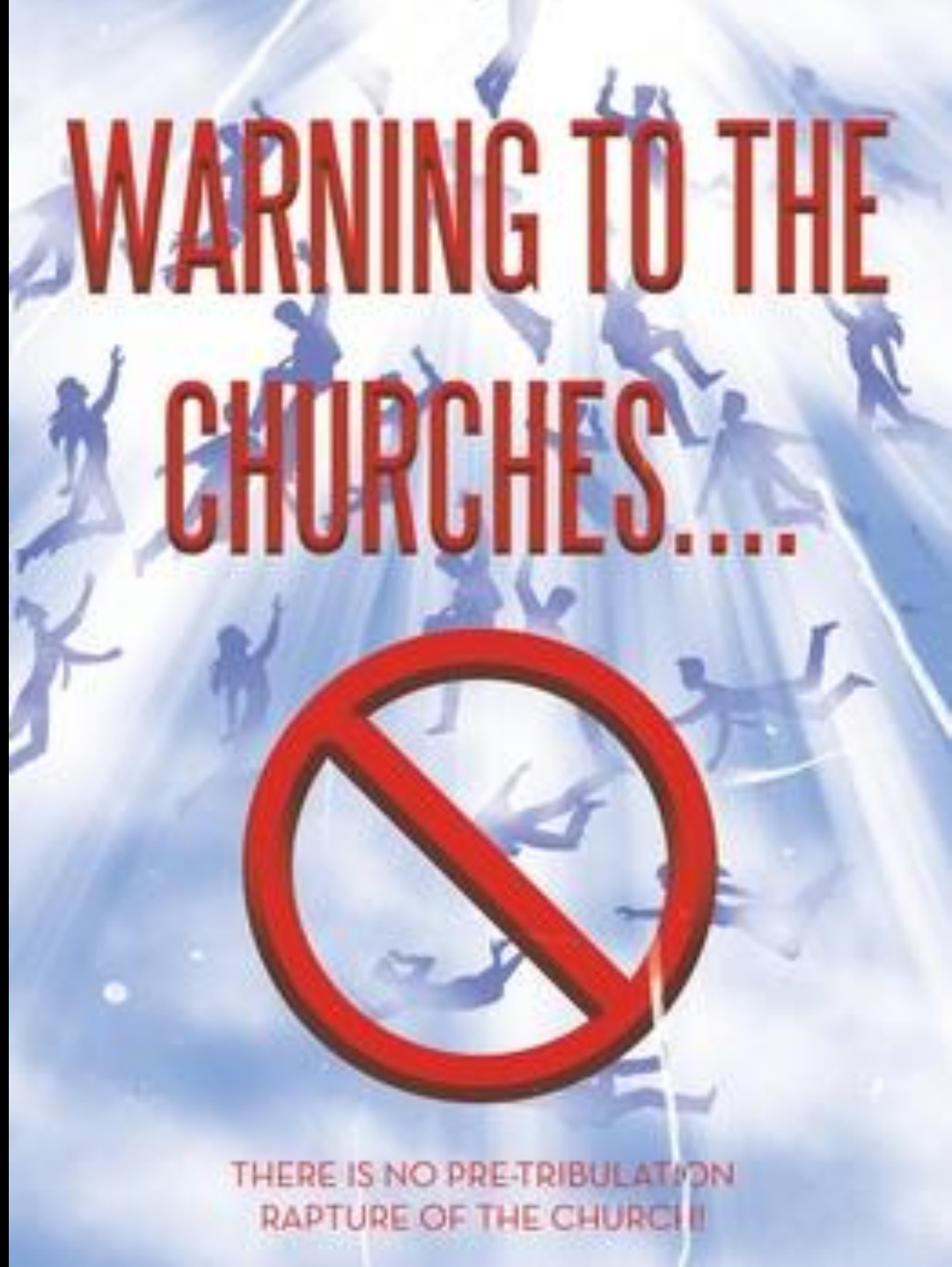

Rev 1:9 “I John, your brother and partner in THE tribulation and THE kingdom.”



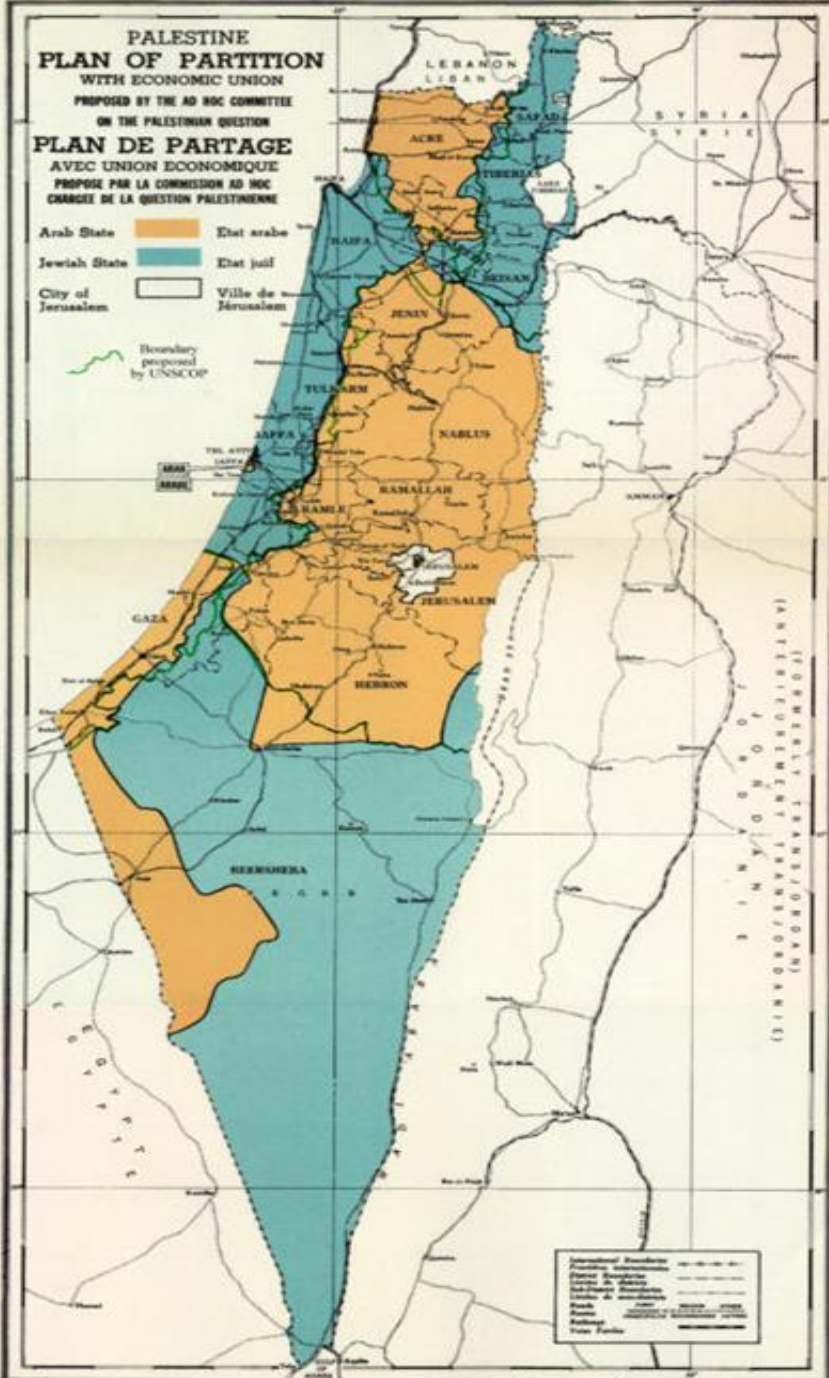

Chrysostom “the Jews set about to rebuild their temple, three different times. Once under Adrian, when they brought desolation upon themselves; a second time under Constantine the Great, who dispersed them, cut off their ears, and branded their bodies with the marks of rebellion. Third, under Julian in 363. God prevented the work with earthquakes, fire from the ground and marks on bodies. God himself visibly baffled their endeavors, to show that no human power could reverse his decree.”

There are only two figures specifically called “witnesses” in the Book of Revelation, Christ and the Church.

Rev 1:5 “from Jesus Christ the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of kings on earth.”

Rev 3:14 “The words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness”

Rev 2:13 “I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is. Yet you hold fast my name, and you did not deny my faith even in the days of Antipas my faithful witness, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells.”

Rev 12:11 “They have conquered him (Satan) by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death.”

Rev 17:6 “And I saw the woman, drunk with the blood of the saints, the blood of the martyrs of Jesus.”

Rev 6:9-10 “I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the witness they had borne. 10 They cried out with a loud voice, "O Sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long before you will judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"

Deut 19:15 “One witness shall not rise against a man concerning any iniquity or any sin that he commits; by the mouth of two or three witnesses the matter shall be established.”

John 8:13-18

“The Pharisees challenged him, “Here you are, appearing as your own witness; your testimony is not valid.” Jesus answered, “Even if I testify on my own behalf, my testimony is valid, for I know where I came from and where I am going. . . . But if I do judge, my decisions are true, because I am not alone. I stand with the Father, who sent me. In your own Law it is written that the testimony of two witnesses is true. I am one who testifies for myself; my other witness is the Father, who sent me.”
